The Aircraft




The Bicycle

The Photocopier

The first photocopier was invented in 1938 by Chester F. Carlson. In 1947, the Haloid Company, which later became the Xerox Corp., partnered with Carlson to manufacturer his photocopier, and the first office copier was introduced onto the market in 1959.

John Logie Baird was a Scottish engineer and inventor of the world's first working television system in Hastings, England, in 1923. The system was successful enough to become commercialized, and the BBC world's first regular television broadcasts in January 1929, using Baird's system.



The Computer

The computer which was design and constructed was financed by the United States Army during World War II. Built in the 1940s, weighed 30 tons, was eight feet high, three feet deep, and 100 feet long, and contained over 18,000 vacuum tubes that were cooled by 80 air blowers.


The Camera
